WHAT'S ON THE BALLOT?


Contests may include:

WHAT ARE PRIMARIES?

Primaries are elections that political parties use to select candidates for a general election. The candidates who win the primaries become party's nominees in the November election.



DO YOU NEED TO REGISTER WITH A PARTY TO VOTE IN THE PRIMARIES?

Texas has open primaries. Voters do not need to register with a political party, but may only vote in one party's primary within the same year.



Return signed application by mail, email or fax (the original must be received by Feb. 20, 2026).



Voters must provide a TX ID or driver's license number, Election ID certificate, or the last 4 of their SSN
